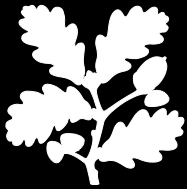

While respecting and preserving the words verbatim, they have been taken out of context and placed in the mouths of Winston the Evangelist, Winston the Prophet, Winston the Comic, Winston the Actor, Winston the Pugilist and Winston the Gangleader.
